

be able to retrieve your information. And who do you think is storing this information? Are you concerned that they will be able to look into your personal information?


Are you aware that Google Drive is one such example of a cloud based service? I don’t know what their privacy policies are with it, but what if they could scan through your documents and see where you went for your honeymoon, and then present ads on your computer that asked you if you wanted to get a discounted vacation at this same location. Something like: “Rekindle your romance in Hawaii- discounts starting at 50%”, or something along those lines. Does that seem so farfetched? Not really, because that’s what they were doing with Gmail for some time.

So let’s look at the trend of technology and see what “options” are currently saturating the market. I won’t be picking on Google as the sole violator on this subject- there are plenty of others who play into this game.



We’ve got Apple’s iWatches that monitor your heart rate all day long and a new app for the iPhone called “Health” that analyzes your vitals for you. There are location trackers on most all smart phones and you pretty much can’t operate any software without signing a terms & agreement statement (that nobody reads). That means that the fun little “free” game app you downloaded not only is looking at your contact list on your phone, but potentially selling it to large data mining companies that do whatever they want with that information (they claim they package it up as marketing bundles so advertisers can study demographics).

A researcher named Jay Dyer commented on this exact issue when he detailed the number of monitors we are surrounded by on a regular basis: heart rate, sleep, and location monitors all originate from the Schwitzgebel Machine that was conceived at Harvard Medical School in the 1960s.



A journal article called *Anthropotelemetry: Dr. Schwitzgebel's Machine* was published in 1966 in the Harvard Law Review that started with this disturbing note:

"An electronic device capable of tracking the wearer's location, transmitting information about his activities, communicating with him, and perhaps modifying his behavior is now in experimental use in Cambridge, Massachusetts. This method of surveillance differs from eavesdropping in that the wearer is aware of it and may have consented at least nominally, to its use. Since the wearer carries the device with him, it can be used to keep him under continuous surveillance. Partly because of these factors, tracking is likely to have a stronger effect on behavior than eavesdropping."

Note that it foreshadows the apathetic acknowledgement of apps and smartphones tracking our information with this statement:

"This method of surveillance differs from eavesdropping in that the wearer is aware of it and may have consented at least nominally, to its use."

Like I said before, most of us download free apps and openly acknowledge that we're not going to read the terms and conditions. Some of us don't even care that they're taking our personal data and tracking our movements. Heck, it's a free game! Nothing is "free" my friends...

## AN AGE WITHOUT LIMITS

So now that we've talked about some of the key concepts of privacy invasion, data mining, and this digital world the occultists seek to bring about; let's hypothesize how this thing gets wrapped up.

We've seen large pushes in this direction with massive data storage facilities like the NSA's PRISM data warehouse in Utah called "Bumblehive." The Bumblehive data center can house enough data to potentially reveal over one million terabytes worth of personal information. A 40-year veteran of the NSA, Richard George, retired in 2011 and asserted it wasn't as nefarious as some theorists claim. He said:

"It's just a big file cabinet out in the Western area. There is no spying going on there."

So what exactly is this data being stored for? It processes phone calls, emails, internet searches, and practically any form of digital fingerprint you could imagine. As of this writing, there isn't much else that is known about this facility, only that which is conjectured by theorists. Exactly whose signals are being stored is also unknown. Many cite the violation of privacy since it inevitably snoops at American's personal data.

To me it sounds an awful lot like the many apps, games, and online searches that are being recorded from earlier in this theory. Perhaps this facility is protecting America from threats, which I have no doubt it does, however it begs the question of how far it could go.

Could we have a Terminator- Skynet type incident where the robots access all of this personal data and use it to their advantage? Is it going to be used to help build a predictive digital universe in which the Illuminati coerce us into living after our Earth is no longer habitable? Perhaps this digital world will be a temporary living condition while we lay dormant in spaceships that are traversing the universe looking for a habitable planet. There are many paths this could take if you let your imagination get carried away.

## REINFORCED MESSAGES

It seems to me that the Illuminati are obsessed with demonizing religion and Christianity. They aim to make believers appear to be 'out of touch dorks', while the "cool" people are those that don't "bow down" to anyone (including God). Atheists are portrayed to be the "intelligent" ones (meanwhile they subscribe to the religion that opposes all other religions, making them just as bigoted as the rest of us who think OUR religion is the only true one).

I have no problem with atheists; in fact many of my friends are atheists. I even understand how they can feel that way. The point I'm making is that entertainment pushes the predictive programming that believing in Christianity is somehow unintelligent, when in fact many intelligent people subscribe to this religion. A similar argument could be applied to other religions as well, but you get the point I'm trying to make.

Many of the New Age schools of thought have picked up steam since the 1960s. Most of the practices of meditation and yoga originate with ideas of communicating with some other worldly entity, no different than the occult rituals of British occultist

Aleister Crowley who evoked several voices and spirits during his period of exploring the dark

side. Crowley even wrote a book about yoga, which is a practice that seeks to unleash the inner kundalini serpent by reversing God's natural energy flow inside of the body, awakening this "enlightenment."

The Illuminati are constantly reinforcing many of these ideas through entertainment. They are even trying to make robots and digital avatars more sexy and appealing. In films like *Her* they have Scarlet Johansson dictating the voice of the sexy artificial intelligent operating system. Johansson also played a sexy alien in the film *Under the Skin*. Kristina Loken plays the robotic dealer of death in *Terminator 3*. Katy Perry depicts herself as an alien from outer space in her video for E.T. The digital character of the video game *Tomb Raider* featured a sexy Laura Croft (later portrayed by Angelina Jolie in the film). Even the men get in on it as iconic figures such as rappers like Lil Wayne, The Game, Kanye West, and basketball player Metta World Peace all have made claims that they are not human; they are aliens.

All of these things play into the collective unconscious and tell our brains that non-humans can be attractive; even sexy.

The next step will be to lure people into the digital universe through sexual desires. Apps and toys are already on the market that allows people to simulate sex via long distance connections through undergarments that interface with the computer. In due time websites will allow people the ability to have these kinds of hook ups with adult film stars or just old fashioned working girls. I'm not claiming that women are to blame, I'm saying that men are going to be the first to fall for this trick because of how the male is wired up in terms of their emotional stimulation.

Speaking of connections with other people; let's take another look at one of the advancements from Google that is of concern: Google Translate. This software makes it easy to read web pages that are written in foreign languages. You simply click a button and the entire language is decoded into whatever language you choose. Does anyone recall why this sounds familiar? This sounds like the lesson learned in the Old Testament's Tower of Babel. In this example

the occultists might think that they are finally proving God wrong when He broke up man's "greatest creation" (referring to Babel- the tower that man built to reach the heavens in an attempt to become god- like) and God made everyone speak different languages so we couldn't communicate with one another and collaborate on such dastardly ideas.



Fast forward hundreds of years, and we've got narcissism running rampant with people obsessing over how many others are "following" them on Twitter or Facebook. Rappers are literally referring to themselves as "god", and celebrities are being worshipped as if it were true as well.

It seems to me there's a cyclical component here; perhaps like Atlantis and other high technology we observe on shows like *Ancient Aliens*. After some time the technology will advance and spiral out of control exponentially- as every technology curve such as Moore's Law shows us. At this point the digital mark of the beast will be upon us and it will be up to us as to which world we choose to live in. If we choose to go into man's digital world, it could be just another iteration of previously "enlightened" civilizations who thought they were going to ascend into the next revolution of mankind, only to succumb to unseen errors.

If there was anything I could use as evidence to support these theories I'm deriving (besides everything else I've mentioned thus far), I'd argue that the political and consumerism climate in which we live is proof positive of a conspiracy. The Illuminati use magic tricks to distract us on one hand, while they're doing what they want with the other.

## GOOGLE AND THE AGE OF ROBOTS



SearchImageLand.com posted an article about the Google X secret projects, in which they talked about Google's obsession with robots:

Robots figure prominently in many of the ideas. They have long captured the imagination of Google engineers, including Mr. Brin, who has already attended a conference through robot instead of in the flesh.

Fleets of robots could assist Google with collecting information, replacing the humans that photograph streets for Google Maps, say people with knowledge of Google X. Robots born in the lab could be destined for homes and offices, where they could assist with mundane tasks or allow people to work remotely, they say.

If you've ever seen The Matrix films, you can guess where this may be headed. In particular; The Animatrix had one video that showed how the world accepted these robotic servants, and things slowly spiralled out of hand to the point that the robots rebelled and took us over. A film called Her showed us how an artificial intelligence was able to seduce a man and eventually become self-aware and join other A.I.'s. And even more recently we saw a film called Chappie that promoted the idea that robots have feelings.

The way we might find ourselves being challenged by robots such as these is by a slippery slope of technology.

Google has been instrumental in embedding their search engine into everything, and have since expanded into email and data storage. They've released the Google Glasses that make technology wearable, and eventually we'll no doubt be putting technology into our bodies.

Google also hired Ray Kurzweil as the director of engineering; further pushing the Age of Aquarius and the transhumanism agenda. I've long been talking about Ray Kurzweil because he's a brilliant futurist who has been able to predict technology trends using Moore's Law and other such prediction tools.

Not only did they hire Ray Kurzweil, but they also picked up Geoffrey Hinton; a prominent computer scientist and neural computation expert, who will help Google's A.I. conduct 'deep learning' where the computer will learn abstract cognition and eventually think and learn like a human through a neural network of sorts.

Kurzweil believes that we can eventually become immortal or even bring deceased people back into a digital existence. These advancements in artificial intelligence reach their pinnacle during a time he dubs "The Singularity" when A.I. becomes so smart that they surpass us humans, while obtaining their own consciousness.

He believes that we'll approach "The Singularity" in the next 15-30 years, and not only does he believe this, he seeks it.

I believe that the practitioners of the occult have been pushing us towards this robotic consciousness, including the idea that we've been programmed by the media and others to believe that we humans are very bad (e.g. environmental pollution and destruction, wars, greed, etc.) and might even deserve to be enslaved by the robots.

Here's a snippet from an article at TheGuardian about Kurzweil that should have some cause for alarm, as we see Google ramping up its A.I. labs for Kurzweil and his team:

It's since been revealed that Google has gone on an unprecedented shopping spree and is in the throes of assembling what looks like the greatest artificial intelligence laboratory on Earth; a laboratory designed to feast upon a resource of a kind that the world has never seen before: truly massive data. Our data. From the minutiae of our lives.


Google has bought almost every machine-learning and robotics company it can find, or at least, rates.

It made headlines two months ago, when it bought Boston Dynamics, the firm that produces spectacular, terrifyingly life-like military robots, for an "undisclosed" but undoubtedly massive sum. It spent \$3.2bn (£1.9bn) on smart thermostat maker Nest Labs.

And this month, it bought the secretive and cutting-edge British artificial intelligence startup DeepMind for £242m.


And those are just the big deals. It also bought Bot & Dolly, Meka Robotics, Holomni, Redwood Robotics and Schaft, and another AI startup, DNNresearch...

And it has embarked upon what one DeepMind investor told the technology publication Re/code two weeks ago was "a Manhattan project of AI". If artificial intelligence was really possible, and if anybody could do it, he said, "this will be the team". The future, in ways we can't even begin to imagine, will be Google's.



Another idea is that the computers are already smarter than us. For example, how often are we faced with a question and we immediately consult our cell phones? These things didn't exist 20 years ago; if we didn't know the answer we were just a moron. If we did know it, we were considered the smart person. Now, everyone has the cell phone and internet to augment their minds and make them smart. We're already implementing the augmentation of Google and the internet to answer our questions. We're effectively already slaves to the digital gods and goddesses.

Ray Kurzweil's father passed away some time ago and Kurzweil has openly said that he wants to bring him back to life so he can be with him in this interactive digital Matrix-Facebook world. In an interview with ABC he said the following:


"Creating an avatar of this sort is one way of embodying that information in a way that human beings can interact with. It is inherently human to transcend limitations."

So now that we can believe that Google is picking up Ray Kurzweil to help engineer the "ultimate" artificial intelligence, let's get a bit deeper on this occult concept of immortality. On March 8th, 2015, Google Ventures' president Bill Maris made the revelation that they believe humans will soon be able to live 500 years.

"If you ask me today, is it possible to live to be 500? The answer is yes."

This sub-project of Google is investing hundreds of millions of dollars into human sciences (e.g. robots) in an attempt to overcome the notion that we will all decay away at some point. They're also investing in startup companies like the Uber taxi service, but the lion share of their investments lie in Life Sciences. Bill Maris reiterated one of Kurzweil's axioms by saying the following about our new robotic versions:

"It will liberate us from our own limitations."



I read into that to say the same thing I've been exploring: these people believe that they are the new gods. They believe they will "improve" upon the true God's creation and overcome His

"limitations." This falls in line with many occult and satanic beliefs that there is something inherently wrong with God's creation of human. Satan was rejected from Heaven for these types of thoughts, and ancient myths of Prometheus echo the same concept.

Seeking some kind of forbidden knowledge is what the occultists are after, and the immortal 'god' life is precisely what they are looking for. That's not to say we're flawless and shouldn't try to improve ourselves through technology, or seek to eradicate diseases or problems. I just think these people are approaching this from a much different mindset than that.

Consider that the Google Ventures organization is also investing in SpaceX, which is a way for regular people to get into space, one has to see that we might be on the path of the film Prometheus where they are attempting to reconnect with their alien gods, or perhaps colonize Mars.

If you think all of that alien talk is far-fetched; take a look at the Typhonian O.T.O. magical order that uses magick rituals to evoke aliens and other worldly entities. It plays out the occult agenda in both the aspect of ritually evoking spirits and also trying to conform the universe into the will of the practitioners.

For a more practical example, see the Illuminati symbolism of Katy Perry's Super Bowl performance, where she is calling upon extra-terrestrials in her performance, when during the ritual UFOs took the city of Phoenix before her show.
